32nd Annual MLK Celebration | January 15, 2026

Theme: Shaping our future with courage and compassion

Community Celebrating Diversity's (CCD) 32nd annual **Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.**Celebration is one of Scottsdale's most meaningful signature events, born from the vision of founders Sandra Rembrandt, Art DeCabooter, Cindy Slick and Don Logan. What began as a local alternative to valley-wide celebrations has grown into a powerful evening that brings together civic leaders, educators, students, and community members to honor Dr. King's legacy of equality, justice, and peace. The celebration features **nationally recognized speakers**, dynamic cultural presentations, and the honoring our Diversity Champions. CCD recognizes individuals who exemplify Dr. King's principles by empowering others and promoting equity in our community. This year's event structure has been intentionally designed to create space for community leaders to connect and collaborate. with small plates served before the program and dessert offered afterward, **allowing for valuable dialogue and relationship-building around advancing diversity and inclusion in our community.**

Proceeds from the event directly support CCD's \$2,500 youth scholarships, awarded annually to up to six high school and SCC students who demonstrate academic achievement, leadership, and a commitment to community service. To encourage innovation and scientific achievement, two scholarships are dedicated to students pursuing STEM careers. Since 2007, more than \$165,000 in scholarships have been awarded to over 69 deserving students.

Youth Voices

CCD partners with the Scottsdale Unified School District to present the Youth Voices program, giving area students a chance to hear from our MLK keynote speaker and engage in meaningful conversations about civil rights, social justice, and leadership. Over the years, more than 28,000 middle and high school students have participated, making it one of the largest youth-focused diversity education events in the region.

By bringing Dr. King's message directly into schools, Youth Voices helps inspire the next generation of change-makers and ensures that the principles of inclusion and equity remain a priority in our educational institutions.

Youth Scholarship

Community Celebrating Diversity also provides a scholarship, which is funded by the corporate sponsors of the annual Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. celebration. CCD sponsors up to six \$2,500 scholarships to high school graduates and SCC students who show promise of continued excellence in academics and community service. Since 2007, over 69 students have been awarded a total of \$165,000 in scholarships. Awards will be granted based on academic achievement, demonstrated community service, financial need, and an essay on the importance of respecting diversity. The selection criteria and procedures are designed to ensure that all eligible students receive consideration without regards to race, color, national origin, sex, religion, disability, sexual orientation, or economic background.

Diversity Champions

Each year, CCD honors **Diversity Champions.** These are individuals who embody the spirit of Dr. King and actively enrich their communities by advancing inclusion, equity, and empowerment. More than **63 champions** have been recognized for their work across education, public service, and advocacy. Their stories serve as powerful examples of how ordinary citizens can make extraordinary contributions.

Diversity Dialogue Event

In addition to MLK events, CCD is expanding its community engagement through the **Diversity Dialogue Community Event**, an interactive public forum designed to foster open conversations, shared understanding, and actionable solutions around topics of race, equity, and belonging.
